Mary and Joseph Go to Bethlehem

God had promised a Savior would be born in Bethlehem. Mary and Joseph did not live in Bethlehem. A rule was made that everyone had to return to his family's town to be **taxed**. Mary and Joseph were from King David's family and had to go to Bethlehem to be taxed.

In Bethlehem, Mary had her baby. He was born in a **stable** because they could find no room to rent. They had no bed for the baby, so they laid him in a **manger**.

Mary and Joseph were so happy. They named the baby Jesus just like God had told them.




