Student athletes who are being homeschooled and playing for a local school in a team or individual sport, or those student athletes who are pursuing athletic competition in a variety of fields including preparing for competitions will want their course work in high school approved by the NCAA to meet academic eligibility requirements for scholarships and participation.

These student athletes must balance the demands of a challenging sport training and competition schedule, while being able to devote the necessary time to their academic program. NFC Academy understands these unique student needs and provides a program of academic quality while allowing the student athlete to devote the necessary time to their athletic pursuits.

The NCAA has established regulations for courses that these student athletes take in a non-traditional setting. NFC Academy is an accredited school by the Middle States Commission on Elementary and Secondary Schools and core courses in the NFC Academy High School are approved by the NCAA to meet athletic eligibility as they enter college. The student is responsible for ensuring that he or she meets NCAA Core Course requirements.

NFC Academy students should consult with our Guidance staff for information about meeting NCAA Core Course requirements. The NCAA recommends that students set up their own personal account with the NCAA and the student can do so by visiting the [NCAA Eligibility Center](#) (click). The publication by the NCAA of [NCAA Division I Initial-Eligibility Requirements](#) should be downloaded and reviewed by the parent and student.
