COLLEGE PREPARATORY PROGRAM

For those in the College Preparatory Program track World (foreign) Language is required and higher level math and science are recommended. Additional electives may be taken when approved by the Guidance Department. Depending upon local and state rules some students may be eligible to take Dual Enrollment from local Community Colleges/Colleges. Notify the Academy if this is a consideration and approved courses may substitute for some requirements.

TUITION

Standard tuition for High School is for five (6) courses and students taking an elective would be charged the tuition for Homeschool Advantage with additional courses.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

High School juniors and seniors may be academically qualified to take dual enrollment courses from a institution of Higher Education. Parents may wish to research dual enrollment options locally at a community college, four-year college or university. NFC Academy offers an option for dual enrollment at the University of Northwestern (St. Paul), a Christian college providing Early College opportunities to qualified students. Simply dual enrollment means a student takes a course from a college for college credit and can receive high school credit for the same course. In some instances the course may meet a specific high school graduation requirement, but if not, will be considered an elective. Families interested in dual enrollment should let our Academic specialist know during the process of completing the student's Path to Graduation.

HONORS COURSES

These honor level courses from Edgenuity are not written from a biblical worldview and you may find some material that is different from that view we hold--from our web page on a biblical worldview "we look to the Bible for our beliefs and how we should operate. That means our curriculum will be written from that view." We have included these optional courses in these areas because we believe they will challenge our students academically. They will also cause the student to think critically knowing what a secular view says and knowing a biblical worldview. We will expect our students in all situations to know the biblical worldview so they can carefully and thoroughly present sound arguments consistent with a biblical worldview. Students uncomfortable with this process should enroll in one of our other courses written from a biblical worldview.
